What is the WIPA program?

Work Incentives Planning and Assistance (WIPA) is a Social Security funded program that provides benefits counseling to Social Security Disability beneficiaries who are interested in work.



Who is Eligible?

Social Security beneficiaries, age 14 to full retirement age, who receive any of the following:

- Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI)
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Childhood Disability Benefits (CDB)

WIPA services are available to individuals currently working or actively seeking work.

All inquiries and services are kept strictly confidential and are <u>free of charge</u>.

How can a Community Work Incentives Coordinator (CWIC) help you?

- Understand Social Security Disability benefits programs as well as other federal, state, and local programs for which you might be eligible
- Provide healthcare planning and counseling
